Executive Summary

GOVERNOR: Governor DeWine invited doctors from all corners of the state to discuss the high incidence rate that they are seeing in their communities. Moderated by new ODH Chief Medical Officer, Dr. Bruce Vanderhoff, doctors from Cleveland, Columbus, Cincinnati and Lima all sounded an alarm that they are seeing a tremendous amount of spread that is leading to a significant uptick in COVID-19 patients in their hospitals.

All the medical professionals implored Ohioans to say no to gatherings and to double down on efforts to reduce the spread.
