Executive Summary

GOVERNOR: During today's press conference, DeWine invited Department of Medicaid Director, Maureen Corcoran, and Department of Aging Director, Ursel McElroy to discuss efforts that are being made to keep Ohio's nursing homes safe.

Director Corcoran discussed the typical policies that most facilities have implemented across the state as far as disinfecting and distancing. Additionally, Ohio has started a program call PARRT, Post-Acute Regional Rapid Testing, which puts a team into a setting quickly to test people and identify if additional testing is needed for all facility residents.

Director McElroy announced the start of a program Ohio is calling "Staying Connected." Although not intended solely for nursing home residents, the program began as a way to virtually connect those who are unable to see their loved ones during this time. More details on the program will be forthcoming.



FEDERAL GUIDANCE: OSHA has released extensive guidance for preparing workplaces for COVID-19. The CDC has also issued guidance for cleaning and disinfecting workplaces, schools, public spaces and homes.
