Executive Summary

GOVERNOR: State officials on Tuesday replaced a previous order that limited Ohioans' movement with an "urgent health advisory" that instead recommends citizens follow best practices to help slow the spread of the coronavirus.

The advisory preserves recommendations to avoid groups of more than ten people, practice physical distancing and maintain advanced sanitation practices.

"Ohioans have risen to the challenge in the past we will continue to do so as we move through this period of time," Gov. Mike DeWine said.

Limits on travel will also be loosened, the governor said.

"We're now moving from orders to strong recommendations," he said.

Following social distancing guidelines and budget shortfall, Tiffin City Council decided during its meeting Monday, May 18, 2020, that the City Pool would not open for 2020 and that the Independence Day fireworks display would be postponed until later in the year. City Council deferred to the city administration, which in turn is tentatively planning for the event to occur on Labor Day weekend.

A factor for the closure of the City Pool is due to increased cost of pool operations due to social distancing guidelines due to the COVID-19 pandemic and a budget shortfall from decreased income tax collections. Revenue figures for 2020 shows the city with a loss of \$677,50 compared to 2019. The fireworks display is being postponed due to social distancing guidelines.

Due to the concern over COVID-19, Tiffin Parks and Recreation cancelled all public programs, events and facility reservations effective March 18 until further notice. Sports leagues have not been cancelled as they are run by a separate not-for profit organization.
