Executive Summary

GOVERNOR: Governor DeWine did not hold his daily briefing today. His next COVID-19 press conference will be Tuesday, June 2nd.

EXECUTIVE ORDERS: Late Friday, a new order was released by the Department of Health that revises the order for business openings and social distance. These guidelines include extending the 10-person gathering limit through June with the exception of weddings and funerals. Venues hosting these events, however, are required to follow proper social distancing and mask policies.

The department also rescinded its order to prohibit liquor sales to out-of-state customers in border counties in northeast Ohio.

Governor DeWine reports that there is now an email set up to coordinate donations and offers to help. This address is together@governor.ohio.gov.

Ohio State Fair:

The Expo Commission has cancelled the 2020 Ohio State Fair due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The Ohio State Fair's management team along with the Ohio Expo Commission evaluated information from state and local health officials, along with the financial feasibility of a reduced attendance over the past several weeks.
