Executive Summary

GOVERNOR: The Governor held a press conference today, and although he said a Monday presser would only occur if there was pressing news, today's press conference came due to a scheduling conflict that prevents him from holding one tomorrow.

During today's press conference, DeWine announced that nursing homes in Ohio would be allowed to conduct outdoor visitation starting July 20th. Long-term care facilities were allowed to begin such visitations on June 8th.

The Governor also announced today that they will be extending the current health orders through the end of this week, which most notably includes the prohibition of mass gatherings.

As the number of positive cases continues to rise in Hamilton and Montgomery Counties, DeWine continued to encourage Ohioans to get tested.

The Ohio State Fair's management team along with the Ohio Expo Commission evaluated information from state and local health officials, along with the financial feasibility of a reduced attendance over the past several weeks.
