Executive Summary

GOVERNOR: The Governor did not hold a press conference today.

LEGISLATURE: Rep. John Becker (R-Clermont County) announced that he has filed charges against Governor DeWine including terrorism, bribery and interfering with civil rights. Becker had tried to impeach DeWine last month.

According to the Cincinnati Enquirer, Becker accuses DeWine of disenfranchising voters, threatening the health of Ohioans by closing hospitals to non-emergency procedures and shuttering businesses in a private citizen affidavit filed with Clermont County Municipal Court Monday.

Asked for comment, DeWine spokesman Dan Tierney replied: "If this were serious, I would have a comment. Because it is patently absurd, I do not."
