Executive Summary

GOVERNOR: During today's press conference, Governor DeWine warned that this pandemic is not over, a more accurate description would be to say the state is at halftime. "Things will get better, but in all likelihood, they will get worse before they get better. And we're already seeing that in the trend lines of the last several weeks," he said.

DeWine said that ODH will soon be launching a dashboard to show information about labs that are performing tests, including the type of tests they run, the turn-around time and more. This data will be beneficial for nursing homes, college/universities, employers and K-12 schools.

During the question portion of the press conference, DeWine was asked about using the Rainy-Day Fund. He said right now the state is relying on cuts and hiring freezes, however that money will be used eventually to fund basic services like education.
